PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR TERMINATING STATES OF EMERGENCY

18-02

I, Jay R. Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, terminate the following proclamations pursuant to RCW 43.06.210:

- 1. Proclamation 15-15 dated November 18, 2015, which proclaimed a state of emergency in all counties of the State, and activated the organized militia, for damage to roadways, transportation systems, utility systems, infrastructure, homes and businesses, in addition to injuries and death to people, caused by a series of severe rain and wind storms.
- 2. Proclamation 15-16 dated December 9, 2015, which proclaimed a state of emergency in all counties of the State, and activated the organized militia, for damage to roadways, transportation systems, utility systems, infrastructure, homes and businesses caused by a series of severe rain and wind storms.
- 3. Proclamation 17-04 dated March 17, 2017, which proclaimed a state of emergency in Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Whitman, Walla Walla, and Yakima counties, and activated the organized militia, for damage to roadways, utility systems, homes and businesses caused by a series of severe rain storms from March 10 through March 20, 2017.
- 4. Proclamation 17-05 dated March 31, 2017, amending Proclamation 17-04 to extend its application through April 3, 2017, and added Cowlitz and Mason counties due to expanding storm conditions throughout the State.
- 5. Proclamation 17-07 dated April 21, 2017, amending Proclamations 17-04 and 17-05 to extend their application through April 21, 2017, due to expanding storm conditions spreading throughout the State.
- 6. Proclamation 17-08 dated May 18, 2017, amending Proclamations 17-04, 17-05, and 17-07 to include Pierce County due to damage from the series of severe rain storms that occurred from March 10 through April 21, 2017.

7.	Proclamation 17-12, dated September 2, 2017, which proclaimed a state of emergency in
	all counties in the State for ongoing and threatened wildfires.

8.	Proclamation 17-13 dated December 18, 2017, which proclaimed a state of emergency in
	Pierce and Thurston counties due to the derailment of an Amtrak train in Pierce County
	onto Interstate 5 resulting in loss of life, injuries, and damage to infrastructure.
