PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR TERMINATING STATES OF EMERGENCY 13-07

I, Jay R. Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, under RCW 43.06.210, terminate the following proclamations:

- 1. Proclamation 12-07 dated July 23, 2012, which proclaimed a state of emergency for a series of severe storms that caused extensive damage in Adams, Benton, Chelan, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Jefferson, Kitsap, Kittitas, Klickitat, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Walla Walla, and Yakima counties.
- 2. Proclamation 12-12 dated September 12, 2012, which proclaimed a state of emergency for multiple ongoing fires in Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Skamania, and Yakima counties, and a high risk of severe wildfires in all counties east of the crest of the Cascade Mountains.
- 3. Proclamation 13-01 dated January 16, 2013, which proclaimed a state of emergency for severe storms that caused extensive damage in Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Kitsap, Snohomish, and Wahkiakum counties.
